

GOVERNMENT OF ZAMBIA

ACT

No. 16 of 1982

Date of Assent: 4th April, 1982

An Act to approve the annual estimates of district councils for the financial year commencing on the 1st January, 1982, and ending on the 31st December, 1982, amounting in the aggregate to one hundred and ninety-five million, nine hundred and seventy thousand, four hundred and thirty kwacha estimated revenue; one hundred and ninety-three million, one hundred and nineteen thousand, one hundred and twenty-four kwacha recurrent expenditure; and fifty-four million, three hundred and forty-nine thousand, seven hundred and forty-five kwacha capital expenditure.

ENACTED by the Parliament of Zambia.

Enactment

1. This Act may be cited as the District Councils Estimates Act, 1982.

Short title

2. (1) The annual estimates of district councils for the financial year commencing on the 1st January, 1982, and ending on the 31st December, 1982, as set out in the District Councils Revenue and Capital Estimates Book for such financial year, are hereby approved.

(2) A district council may make transfers between sub-heads of expenditure as approved:

Provided that the total amounts set out in the Schedule hereto in respect of each district council shall not thereby be exceeded.
