The powers of the Minister relating to the authorisation of traders contained in paragraph 3 and 4 of the Control of Goods (Essential Commodities) Regulations, 1981, are hereby delegated to the District Executive Secretary of the district in which the trader carries on business. | Delegation S.I. | 4. (1) Every application for authorisation to trade in essential commodities shall be in Form 1 set out in the Second Schedule. | Forms |
| (2) Every authorisation to deal in essential commodities shall be in Form 2 set out in the Second Schedule. | |
