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PART IV**GENERAL PROVISIONS****Fees**

24. (1) The fees prescribed in the Second Schedule shall be payable in respect of the matters set out therein.

(2) Where fees are payable in respect of testing a plant variety at another recognised institution or by other breeders, the breeder shall bear the additional cost of the testing.

- (4) The licensee shall comply with the directions of the Institute and the holder in relation to specified matters.
