The Control of Goods Act
(Laws, Volume XIII, Cap. 690)

The Control of Goods (Price Control) (Traditional Beer Prices) Regulations, 1982

IN EXERCISE of the powers contained in section *three B* of the Control of Goods Act, the following Regulations are hereby made:

1. (1) These Regulations may be cited as the Control of Goods (Price Control) (Traditional Beer Prices) Regulations, 1982, and shall be read as one with the Control of Goods (Traditional Beer Prices) Order, 1980, hereinafter referred to as the principal Order.

(2) These Regulations shall come into operation on the 30th January, 1982.

2. The Schedule to the principal Order is hereby revoked and the Schedule set out in the Appendix hereto is substituted therefor.
