## STATUTORY INSTRUMENT No. 5 OF 1984

**The Firearms Act**  
(Laws, Volume III, Cap. 111)

**The Firearms (Amendment of First Schedule)  
Regulations, 1984**

IN EXERCISE of the powers contained in section *fifty-eight* of the Firearms Act, the following Regulations are hereby made:

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Firearms (Amendment of First Schedule) Regulations, 1984, and shall be read as one with the Firearms Act, hereinafter referred to as the principal Act.

2. The principal Act is amended by the repeal of the First Schedule thereto and the replacement thereof of the First Schedule set out in the Appendix hereto.
