The Food and Drugs (Amendment) Regulations, 1992

IN EXERCISE of the powers contained in section *twenty-three* of the Food and Drugs Act, the Minister, after consultation with the Food and Drugs Board hereby makes the following Regulations:

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Food and Drugs (Amendment) Regulations, 1992, and shall be read as one with the Food and Drugs Regulations, 1978, in these Regulations referred to as the principal Regulations.

2. The principal Regulations are amended in Regulation 290 by the deletion of the word "and" immediately after "1.5 per centum of total ash", and the deletion of the full stop immediately after the word "acid", and the insertion of "and not more than 0.1 per centum alcoholic acid expressed as sulphuric acid".
