The development Credit Agreement between the International Development Association (as Lenders) and the Government of the Republic of Zambia (as Borrowers) signed on 6th April, 1994 for the Economic and Social Adjustment Credit equivalent to nine million and seven hundred thousand Special Drawing Rights (SDR 9,700,000).
