The Telecommunications Act (Laws, Volume 26, Cap. 469)

The Telecommunications (Licence Fees) (Amendment) Regulations, 2002

In exercise of the powers contained in section six, seven, eight and twenty-two of the Telecommunications Act, the following Regulations are hereby made:

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Telecommunications (Licence Fees) (Amendment) Regulations, 2002 and shall be read as one with the Telecommunications (Licence Fees) Regulations, 2001, in these Regulations referred to as the principal Regulations.

Title

2. The principal Regulations are amended in Part 1 under the heading "Commencement Licence Fee" by the—

Amendment of Part 1 of Schedule.

- (a) insertion of "Fees Units" immediately above the figures "2,650,000" where they appear for the first time;
- (b) deletion in item 3 opposite the category "A3 Basic International" of "3,975,000" and the substitution therefor of "347,916,666";
- (c) deletion in item 12 of "C4 paying 2,650,000" and the substitution therefor of the following:

C4 National Mobile 152,155,556; and

(d) the addition after item 14 of the following new catergories:

15. Business Telecentres 1-3	2778
16. Business Telecentres 4-6	4167
17. Business Telecentres 7-9	5556
18. Business Telecentres above 10	6944
19. HF (Radio) Telecentres	· 2778

- 17. The principal Regulations are amended in Part II under the heading "Annual Operating Fees" by the—
 - (a) deletion in item II of "C4 paging Services" and the substitution therefor of "National Mobile";
 - (b) addition after item Π of the following:

12. HF (radio) telecentre 2778 fee units; and

(c) deletion of the NOTES and the substitution therefor of the following:

Notes:

- Annual operating fees shall be paid annually and within three months from the anniversary date of the issuance of the licence.
- 2. All fees shall unless otherwise indicated herein, be subject to value added tax in accordance with the Value Added Tax Act Chapter 331 of the Laws of Zambia.
