IN EXERCISE of the powers contained in section *eighty-nine* of the Customs and Excise Act, the following regulations are hereby made:

| 3. Regulation 94 of the principal Regulations is amended in paragraph (a) of sub-regulation (1) by the insertion before the words "aircraft equipment" of the word "stores".  | Amendment<br>of regulation<br>94                         |

| 6. 7. The First Schedule to the principal Regulations is amended by the deletion of Part II and the substitution therefor of the following part:

“Part II: Fee to be paid on any vehicle that remains in Zambia beyond the authorised period.

The fee to be paid on any vehicle that remains in Zambia beyond the period sanctioned by the Customs Division shall be 100 fee units per day or part thereof”.
