IN EXERCISE of the powers contained in Regulation 3 of the Immigration and Deportation Regulations the following Regulations are hereby made:

1. Title

These Regulations may be cited as the Immigration and Deportation Act (Fees) (Waiver) Regulations, 2000.

2. Waiver of fees

The fees payable under regulation 3 of the Immigration and Deportation Regulations are hereby waived in respect of the Class of persons specified in the Schedule.
